Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will continue to use the SEAL scheme to develop the children's PSE development. This will cover a range of group and individual activities to help children explore feelings and how to keep safe.



Communication and Language

We will have the opportunity to listen to a range of stories linked to our topic. We will focus on texts about travel and adventure, as well as factual texts. We will sequence events and retell the stories through play. Children will be encouraged to have talk buddies in circle time to share thoughts and ideas.



Understanding of the World

We will find out about how we travel and where we have travelled to ourselves. This will give the children an opportunity to find out about the local environment and different types of vehicle. We will also be making vehicles of our own and finding out how we can make them faster.



Spring Term Guide

Our project this term is Moving and Travelling

Mathematics

Using the Abacus Maths Scheme we will secure their knowledge of number: recognising numbers, counting and finding one more or less. Using a range of vehicles we will measure weights, lengths and capacity. We will also start to do simple addition and subtraction and how it can be recorded.



Physical Development

PE will take place on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Wednesday's lesson will be with Mr Ireland. We will develop balance, coordination and ball skills. Dance and movement will also be covered on the other days.

We will be encouraged to use a range of mark making tools to develop correct grip and controlled movement.



Literacy

We will continue to use 'Read Write Inc' to develop our Phonic knowledge. All children are now accessing the reading schemes and we aim to hear your child at least three times a week. Please have their books in School at all times. We will also use books about transport and travelling to encourage writing skills, creating short stories or to give information.



Expressive Arts and Design

The class will have music with Mrs Richardson every Thursday, using our topic to inspire songs and sounds. Children will also use their imagination and a range of art media to produce artwork and models linked to travel. They will also be exploring patterns.
