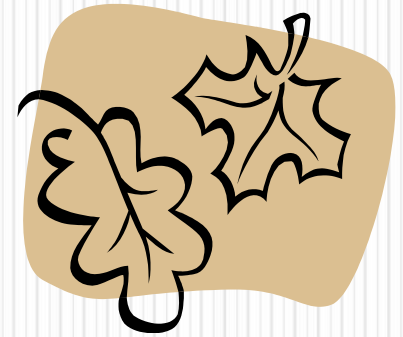
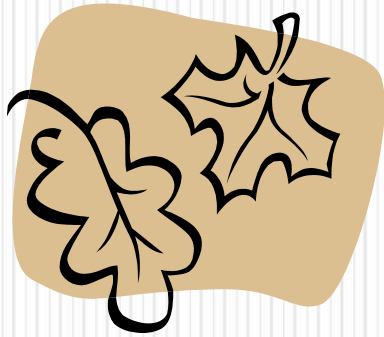

- Each symbol not only represented a phonetic sound but also had a mythical meaning.
- As a group you will produce a poster that will demonstrate your knowledge of the runic alphabet, it's history and why it stopped being used in England.
