

Year 1

Greetings Hello, goodbye and who are we addressing? (Monsieur, Madame, Mademoiselle?)

Year 2

Revision: Games and a song using numbers

Qu'est-ce que c'est? (What is it?) The children will learn the names of different animals and say which animal they have.

Activity 2 Complete the sentence about which animal you have and draw your pet. (2 groups)

Year 3

Revision :Greetings, Ça Va? Comment tu t'appelles? Quel age as-tu?

2. Activity 1: Practise a dialogue and illustrate yourself and a friend.

4. Activity 2: Order conversations and practise.

Year 4

Body parts

Children will learn the names for the main parts of the body using a familiar song, games and other activities. The written words will be used to match up to the correct parts of the body.

Colours

The children will recognize and be able to say the colours in French.

Monster game The children will create monsters in groups using dice and colouring pens.

Year 5

We will look at different types of transport:

On y va! (Let's go!) How do we get to school?

French-speaking countries Can the children find the French-speaking countries and learn the patterns and colours of some flags?

Year 6

Healthy living

The children will look at healthy food items, and compare them to less healthy ones.

Activity 1: Sort healthy and unhealthy food and drink into two different columns. Add to the lists using a dictionary.

Activity 2: Create a healthy menu.

Reception
