### **French Summer Term 2017:**

#### **Class 1- Nursery and Reception**

##### **Basic greetings and introducing oneself:**

- to be able to say hello, goodbye, yes, no, please and thank you
- to be able to ask and say what your name is
- to be able to ask people how they are and say how you are
- to give an opinion on something- it's great!
- to answer the register

##### **Numbers:**

- to be able to say and understand the numbers 1-10

##### **Colours:**

- to be able to say and understand 5-10 colours

##### **Days of the Week:**

- to be able to say and understand the days of the week

We'll be using a variety of songs, rhymes, stories, games and flashcard activities to ensure that children in Early Years have a fun introduction to French.

## Class 2- Year 1 and Year 2

Children in Year 1 and 2 will have fun learning French with songs, rhymes, and games.

### Age:

- to learn the numbers 1-31 and the months of the year
- to ask someone's age and say his or her age
- to ask when someone's birthday is, say when one's birthday is, sing Happy Birthday in French and talk about different celebrations

### Days of the Week:

- to be able to say and understand the days of the week
- to say and write the date in French

### The Alphabet:

- to learn the French alphabet and spell one's name in French

### Parts of the Body:

- to be able to name the different parts of the body

## Class 3- Year 3 and Year 4

Children in Year 3 and Year 4 will have fun learning French with songs, rhymes and games, lessons will incorporate role plays and other creative activities.

### Sports:

- to be able to name different sports
- to play the traditional French game of boules

### Likes and Dislikes/ Favourite Things

- to be able to say which sports they like or don't like
- to be able to say other general likes and dislikes
- to say what their favourite things are
- to understand the preferences of their classmates

### Café:

- to be able to order snacks and drinks in a café
- to create their own French menu
- to recreate a café scene and use all language learnt

## Class 4- Year 5 and Year 6

After learning to describe the appearance of themselves and others with fun and creative activities and games, both year groups will join together to strut down the catwalk in a French Fashion Show to be watched by the rest of the school.

### Descriptions:

- to be able to describe themselves and others (hair, eyes, height etc.)
- to write a description of themselves and a famous person and picture to match

### Clothes and colour adjectives:

- to name items of clothing
- to say what someone is wearing
- to revise colours to describe clothing
- to understand the agreement and position of adjectives

### Fashion Show

- to use all language used on this topic in a fun real life scenario
