

Hampton Lucy French Plans Summer Term 2015- 1st Half-term

Year 1

Les jours de la semaine The children will understand and say the days of the week.

La France The children will share information, pictures or show objects to do with France or the French language.

La France Where is France? Can we pick out some interesting features on a map?

Year 2

Qu'est-ce que c'est? (What is it?) The children will learn the names of different animals and say which animal they have.

Activity 1 Choose a picture of an animal, label and colour it. (2 groups)

Activity 2 Complete the sentence about which animal you have and draw your pet. (2 groups)

Year 3

Party games

Children will take part in and understand a simple party game, using targeted language, and add to their repertoire of games to play in French.

Come to my party Simple party invitations will be completed, copy-writing words accurately and using French dictionaries.

Sports Day The children will learn how to recognize and repeat some familiar sporting activities, for example, skipping and running and say the activities they can do themselves.

Year 4

In the vegetable garden The children will learn the names of some vegetables grown in the garden and how to say which they like and dislike.

Life cycle of a plant The children will describe the life cycle of a plant in French.

Jack and the beanstalk

This is a well-known story to join in with using French words and phrases.

Year 5

At the toy shop The children will learn to express likes and dislikes and begin to learn about the euro.

Likes and dislikes They will learn how to express different levels of like and dislike, ask and answer questions about preferences and learn the sounds French children make when they like or dislike something.

Numbers to 39 Learn the numbers in and out of order using different exercises and activities.

Year 6

Sleeping Beauty

The children will practice creating and saying simple sentences, concentrating on particular sounds. They will practice the verses from the Sleeping Beauty tale in order to perform to the rest of the class.

Reception
