Year 1

Autumn action rhyme.

Instructions: Understanding typical classroom instructions.

Le bonhomme de neige : Action rhyme about a snowman.

Year 2

Qu'est-ce que c'est? (What is it?) The children will learn the names of different animals and say which animal they have.

Activity 1 Choose a picture of an animal, label and colour it. (2 groups)

Activity 2 Complete the sentence about which animal you have and draw your pet. (2 groups)

Year 3

Revision (Final Grid learning session)

Greetings, Ca Va? Comment tu t'appelles? Quel age as-tu? Numbers 0-10.

2. Activity 1: Practise a dialogue and illustrate yourself and a friend.

3. Activity 2: Number pelmanism and a number activity sheet.

4. Activity 3: Order conversations and practise.

The farmer's in his den

This is a well-known song that the children will listen and respond to using family vocabulary with other animals, characters and "le fromage" to complete the song. Can they pick out words from the song to match to pictures? Can the children circle the number of cheeses and other objects and find some other objects to number?

3. Christmas activities The children will learn some Christmas vocabulary in French and match pictures to words.

Year 4

1. Monster game The children will create monsters in groups using dice and colouring pens.

2 & 3. Complete Body and Colours grid learning activity:

Activity 1: Add facial features and hair with colour to an outline of a head. Write sentences to describe what you have drawn (Either the real you or a made up character).

Activity 2: Match the pictures of a cartoon strip to the appropriate captions, using dictionaries to help. Stick them on some paper.

4. Christmas activities The children will learn a song set to a traditional French tune about Pere Noel and his sack of presents, revising numbers and colours.

Year 5

On y va! (Let's go!) How do we get to school?

French-speaking countries Can the children find the French-speaking countries and learn the patterns and colours of some flags?

Christmas activities The children will learn some Christmas vocabulary and talk about French Christmas traditions and those from other countries.

Year 6

Sleeping Beauty

The children will learn a familiar and traditional story in French, listen to and join in with the story sequence and song. Children will listen out for certain sounds and understand how they are represented in writing.

Instructions will be revised, for example, Look (Regardez) and Listen (Ecoutez).

The children will learn to identify and pronounce multiples of 10 to 100. This will enable them to play the Sleeping Beauty game.
